A safari truck bounces you to a close-up view of the African savanna landscape. Along the way, you encounter groups of elephants, giraffe, zebra, wildbeest, gazelle, and ostrich. Then fording a river, visitors see hippos, Nile crocodiles, and a group of colobus monkeys in a stand of trees. Further along, white rhino halt the vehicle as they cross its path, while a pride of lion keeps a close eye on warthogs and kudu from atop a kopje outcropping.

You depart the safari vehicle feeling like you have just been to Africa, even though you have been surrounded by an invisible infrastructure of containment fences and moats, underground utilities, and simulated geologic formations.
