Our master plan focused on preserving the character and integrity of the gardens while enhancing the visitor, research and education facilities.

Our subsequent design development provided the gardens with an expanded Orchid Garden Centre, including a research laboratory and a Cascade Garden within a centuries-old rainforest.

The restored historic Ridley House Meeting Hall, garden structures, the Propagation Center and Shades Houses support the Gardens' pioneering tradition of orchid breeding and exposition.

Future plans include a Spice Garden with emphasis on the economic value of indigenous plants and a Cloud Forest, a climatically-controlled biosphere featuring tropical alpine flora.
